

Highlights of Gujarat Solar Power Policy- 2021



GUJARAT SOLAR POWER POLICY-2021

Solar Power Policy applicable for the year 2021 to 2025.

Surplus Energy generated from the Solar project after set off on billing cycle basis shall be purchased by Respective discom at the following rates:

Surya Gujarat (Residential Solar rooftop Scheme) ,Self-Owned Solar System & MSME Units –

Rs. 2.25 per unit for the 1st 5 years from the date of commissioning and then after remaining 20 years 75% of the simple average of tariff discovered and contracted under competitive bidding process.

In case of Third Party & Non MSME unit-

75% of the simple average of tariff discovered and contracted under competitive bidding process conducted by GUVNL for Non-park based solar projects in preceding 6 Months period. Current rate is Rs. 1.75 per units for Non MSME units and 3rd Party sale.

Transmission charges and loss, Wheeling charges, Cross Subsidy, Additional Surcharges not applicable for a installed solar system in same premises.

Cross Subsidy and Additional Surcharges applicable only for 3rd party selling projects.

Electricity duty will applicable for a projects as per Gujarat Electricity Duty act, 1958. (Solar Generated unit Electricity duty not applied for a Rooftop system.)

No Capacity restriction for a Setting up Solar Power plant in Rooftop or Ground Mounted.

Allowed for selling solar power to third party and Captive based solar power plant.

In Case of HT/ EHV consumer installed Solar Rooftop or Ground Mounted for Captive uses, then the energy set-off shall be allowed 07:00 AM to 06:00 PM of the Same day.

In Case of LT demand based consumers installed Solar Rooftop or Ground Mounted for Captive uses, then the energy set-off shall be allowed 07:00 AM to 06:00 PM of the Billing cycle.

In Case of LT consumers installed Solar Rooftop then the energy set-off shall be allowed billing cycle.

Transmission and wheeling charges and losses as determined by GERC shall be levied as applicable (If Project location & Energy Consumed Location are different.)

Banking charges Rs. 1.50/ unit on Solar Energy consumed in case of Demand Based Consumers shall be applicable. In Case of MSME units and other than Demand Based Consumers, Banking charges shall be applicable Rs.1.10/Unit.

For Resident consumer & Government Buildings
Banking Charges not applicable.

If Solar Power Generator wants to desires to wheel electricity to more than one location, he shall pay Rs. 0.05/ per unit on energy fed into the grid to distribution licensee in whose area power is consumed.
